Proved over a hundred installations already, it provides peace of mind and an early warning against a complete structural failure of the cylinder allowing a home owner to obtain a plumber who can carefully drain and replace the cylinder without doing further damage to the interior decoration of the house.

Pictured here is a cylinder that has just started to leak round a valve, water marks can already be seen around the base of the cylinder. This cylinder should be replaced and have a tray fitted under its replacement to avoid future problems.
