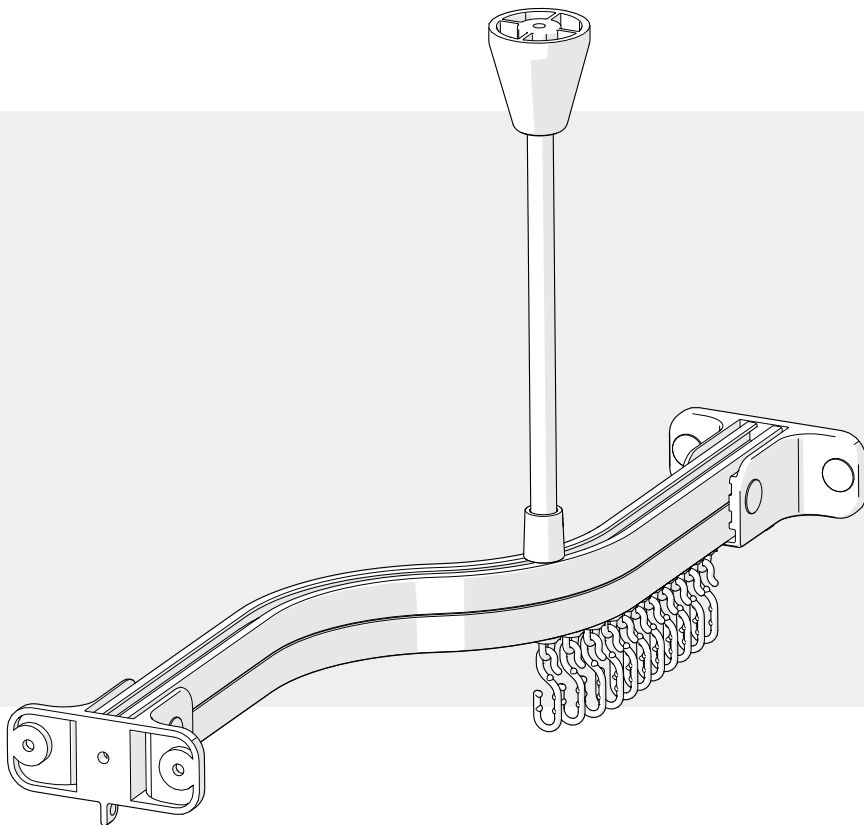














# Bendy Curtain Rail

## INSTALLATION AND USER MANUAL

## Bending the rail

To create the shape you want use the outline of the shower tray as a guide. The curtain rail should always be positioned on the inside of a shower screen. Bend the rail over a smooth curved surface to the required shape. Do not over bend or use a sharp edge as this will distort the rail. After bending measure the rail carefully and cut to the desired length using a fine toothed saw.

## Wall Fixing

Loosely assemble the Bendy Rail (A) and Wall Brackets (B). Position the rail and mark the hole positions of the wall brackets and measure the distance from the ceiling to the top of the wall brackets. The guide dimension for the rail position is 1880 mm above the shower tray. Remove the wall brackets and check the hole positions. Drill fixing holes into the wall using a 5 mm masonry drill (if you are in doubt about the suitability of the fixings for your wall type ask a skilled tradesman). Secure the wall brackets in place with the Wall Fixing Screws (L - No.8 x 1½" pan). Lightly spray rail with silicone lubricant to help Ceiling Hanger Bracket (G) to slide in to the top section of the rail and the Gliders (E) in to the bottom section of the rail. Insert the rail into the wall brackets and secure with Small Screws (J - No.8 x ½" pan). Fix Screw Cover Caps (C).

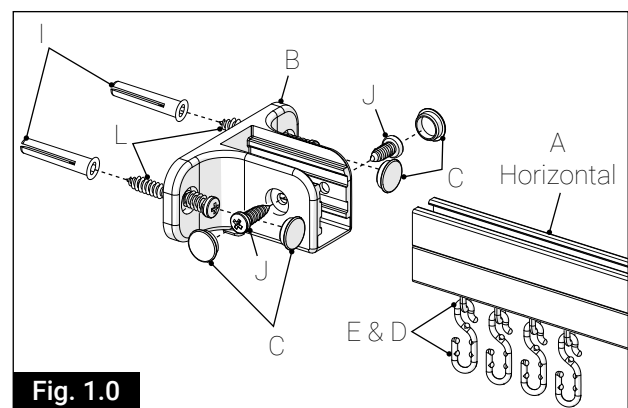

## Ceiling Fixing

Position the Ceiling Hanger Support (F) close to the bend in the rail where it can be secured into a ceiling joist. If a joist cannot be located use a cavity wall fixing for additional strength. Ensure rail is level before cutting Ceiling Hanger Rod (H). Fit ceiling hanger rod into Ceiling Hanger Bracket (G) and secure with Self-Tapping Screw (K - No. 4 x ¼" pan). Mark off hole position when ceiling hanger rod is vertical. Drill into ceiling and fix ceiling hanger support and secure onto ceiling hanger drop rod using self tapping screw.

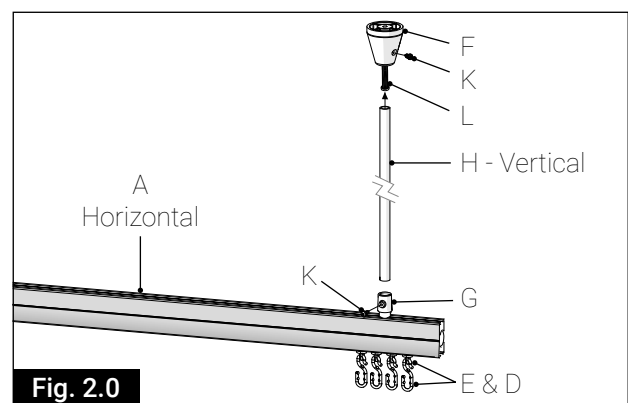
