What material is Halite made of?

Halite panels are constructed from a top quality UV stable expanded vinyl material known as Foamboard. High density PVC board is rigid and durable whilst still being lightweight and flexible.

PVC board is used for a variety of applications, one of the most popular being outdoor shop signage. This is due to it withstanding all of the elements but still remaining in good condition.

Advantages of Halite over other types of bath panels

- Halite is made with a combination of PVC and polyurea.
- Halite is 100% water resistant
- Halite will not crack or warp in wet or steamy environments.
- Halite is considerably more rigid than acrylic.
- Halite is completely formaldehyde free and is recyclable which means it is more eco-friendly.
- The lifespan of Halite bath panels is considerably more than that of MDF bath panels.
- Halite is lighter and easier to cut than MDF.
