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Troubleshooting

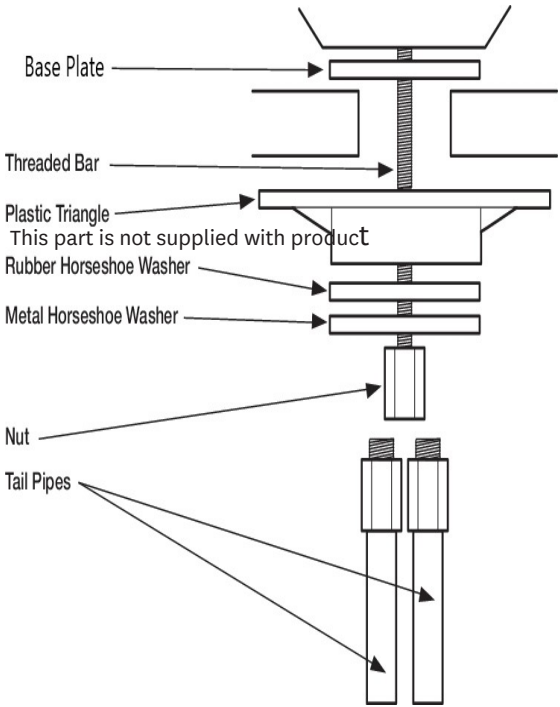
Symptom	Cause(s)	Resolution
Mixer not turning on	Mains Water supply turned off	Turn on the mains water supply
	Closed isolation valve	Open isolation valve
No hot water	Cold override	Check if the pressure is balanced. Fit pressure equalising valve.
Low Flow Rate/No Flow	Water supply failure	Water pressure too low, investigate water supply, check plumbing and heating system for any faults
	Partially closed isolation valve	Open isolation valve
	Air lock or partial blockage in the supply pipework or hoses	Flush through pipework to ensure removal of debris and any airlocks.
	Water being drawn off elsewhere causing pressure changes or instantaneous boiler temperature changes. Ensure minimum pressure is being met.	Try not to use other water outlets when using the mixer
Water dripping from the mixer	This is normal for a short time after using the mixer	This is due to residual water tension, the build up of water in the mixer spout.
	If water continues to drip, possible issue with the flow control cartridge.	Please contact our customer care team.
Movement of fitted mixer	Fixing kit loose	Ensure fixing kit nut is sufficiently tightened.
	Extra support may be required depending on the surface the tap is fitted to.	Please contact customer care to purchase a under sink mounting triangle

Installation Requirements

Before commencing installation of the new product, ensure that the system has been flushed to remove any debris which could cause damage to the valves and invalidate the warranty.

Installation

- 1, Screw the threaded fixing bolt into the bottom of the mixer body
- 2, Screw both Flexi Tails into the tap body, ensuring that the O-Ring on the tail is positioned inside the tap body. Hand tighten, do not use PTFE tape or similar to create the seal.
- 3, Offer the tap up to the hole in the sink.
- 4, On the underside of the sink fit the rubber and metal horseshoe shaped washers onto the threaded fixing bolt and using the nut provided tighten until the tap is secure in the mounting hole. **Note:** If required a under sink mounting triangle can be purchased, this should be used on thin work surfaces to help distribute the weight of the tap and provide a thicker mounting surface for the fixing kit to clamp to.
*(The Sink Mounted Triangle does **NOT** come with this product)*
- 5, Connect the male end of the tail to the corresponding hot and cold inlets.
- 6, Reinstate water supply and test for leaks.

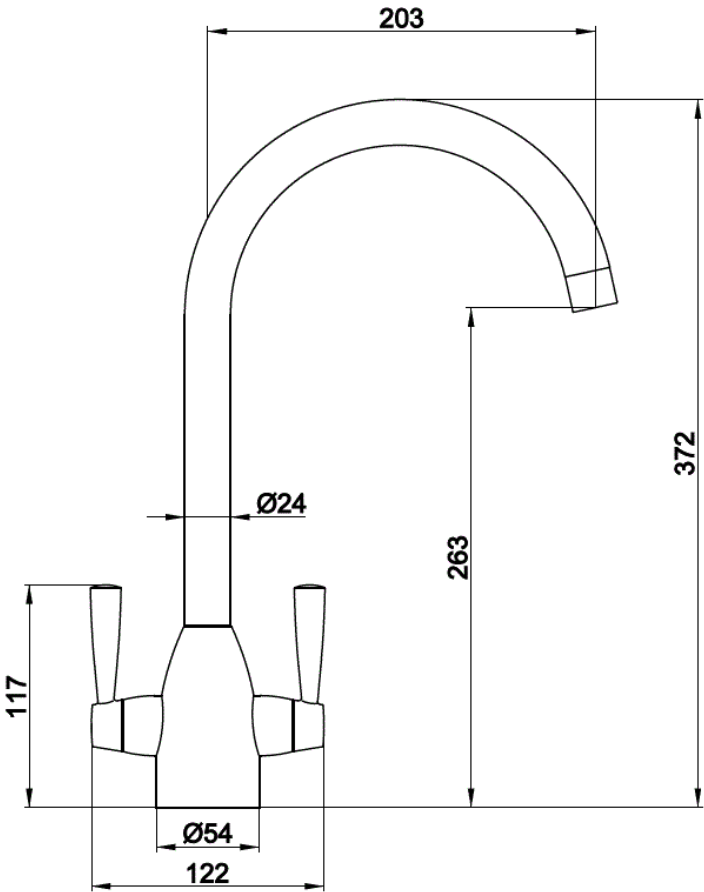
Remove all packaging and check the components for damage before starting installation.

It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure a waterproof seal is achieved, after installation all connections must be checked for leaks.

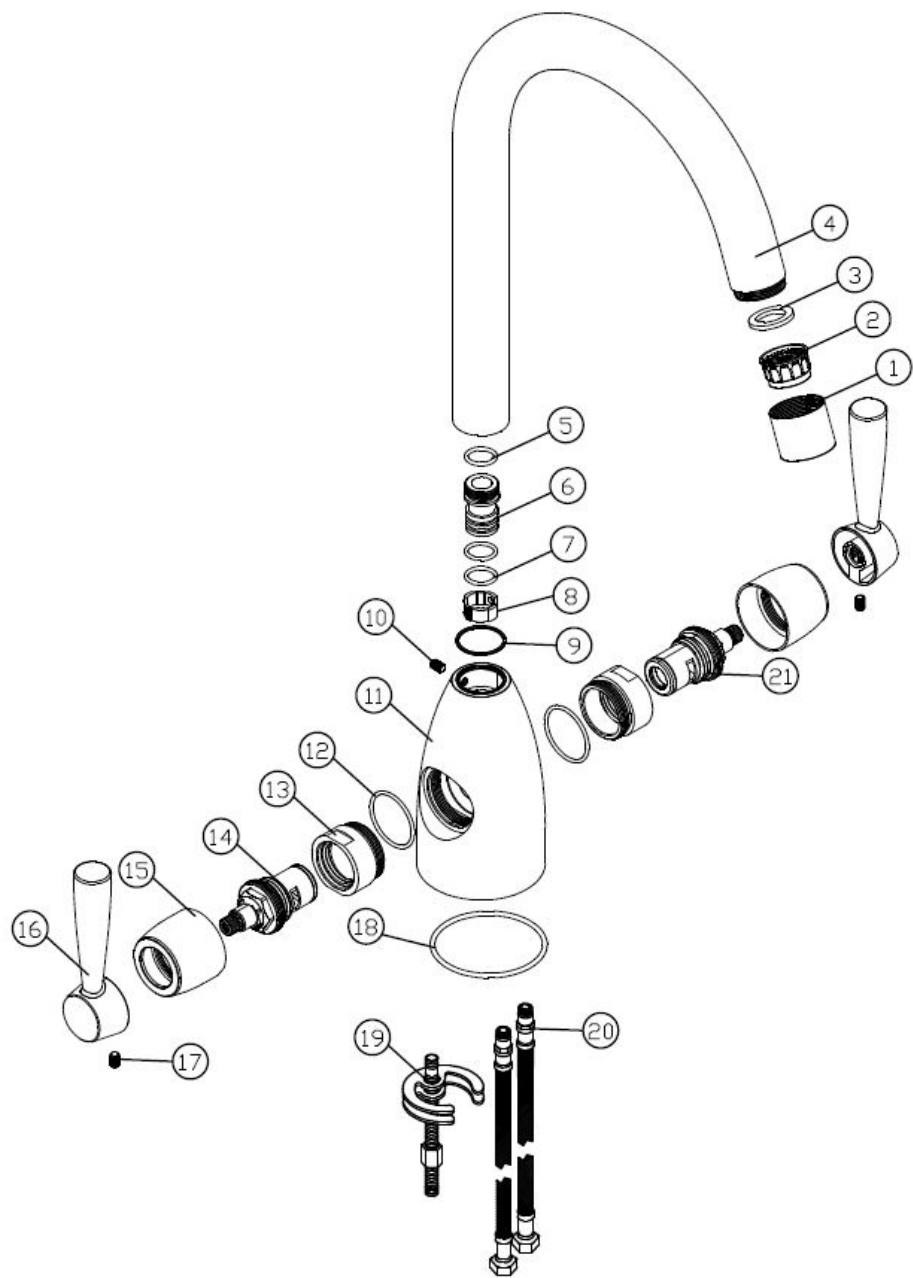
All outlets used primarily for personal hygiene shall deliver water at a safe temperature as per regional regulations.
