


















































Cleaning and Care Instructions - Bathroom Furniture

- Bathroom furniture should be cleaned with a soft dry cloth. Avoid abrasive or sharp objects.
- For removing stubborn dirt, dampen a cloth with warm water and a mild household detergent. Dry surface thoroughly afterwards.
- Furniture should never be cleaned with cleaners containing acid or solvents. Abrasive cleaners should be avoided.
- Wipe up any standing water immediately after use.
- Any chemicals, such as nail varnish remover, hair dyes, bleach or anti- lime scale remover, spilled onto the furniture should be removed straight away.
- Any scratches of the furniture finish should be sealed to avoid water ingress.

Furniture Colour

- Furniture colour may vary slightly from the colour sample
- Lacquered and veneered surfaces are subject to aging and their colour can change over time.
- Continuous exposure to direct sunlight (UV radiation) can speed up the aging process.
