



GriP cleaning recommendation

GriP Intensive Cleaner

GriP intensive cleaner is the recommended cleaner for GriP surfaces. GriP intensive cleaner is an alkaline cleaner concentrate for removing grease and dirt residues.

Routine cleaning with GriP Intensive Cleaner

For normal soiling use approx. 50 -100 ml of GriP Intensive Cleaner in 10 litres of water. Clean the coated area using a mop and then mop again using clear water. Heavy local soiling can be removed using a brush and a slightly higher concentration of intensive cleaner. Use a thinning ration of approx. 1:50 - 1:100 if using a brush-based cleaning machine.

Cleaners

GriP surfaces can also be cleaned with normal bathroom / floor cleaning products. Do not use abrasive and corrosive cleaners to clean a GriP surface. In general, cleaners which are not harmful for your skin can also be used on GriP surfaces.

Do not use rough brushes, steel wool, or other rough cleaning tools on GriP surfaces.

Shower trays, bathtubs or floors with GriP can be cleaned using normal cleaning methods, working according to the above recommendations.

Disinfectants

In general, GriP surfaces are resistant against disinfectants. Always use water to flush the disinfectant away after usage. Moreover, high concentrate disinfectants should not be used. Always thin a concentrate with water and use the disinfectant according to the manufacturer's recommendations. Avoid long exposure of a GriP surface to disinfectants.

GriP surfaces need to dry at least 8 hours. After 8 hours, a surface has dried sufficiently to take a shower. The coating needs to dry for at least five days before cleaning materials / disinfectants can be used.
